## Targeted Coaching Support

### Criteria & Application Process

The Competitions Committee offers coaching support to the winners of the non-senior categories\* at all BPA National competitions\*\*

\* Funding is not available for both Open and Female categories. Only outright winners will be considered.

\*\* The Bodyflight World Challenge/Indoor Skydiving British Nationals are not BPA National competitions.

Coaching support, to a maximum of £600 per team, is to be utilised towards coaching only (not jumps, windtunnel time, entry fees etc) and may be paid after consideration to meeting the criteria.

#### Criteria

1. The team won a non-senior event at the BPA National Championship in the same discipline within the preceding 18 months
2. The team competes at a higher level in the same discipline in the year immediately following their win (eg in 4-way FS progress from A to AA)
3. The team remains the same or where changes may become necessary are subject to allowable team line-up changes – Form 299 for reference

#### Application Process

1. After competing at BPA Nationals let your Discipline Rep and/or the Competitions Committee Secretary – [skydive@bpa.org.uk](mailto:skydive@bpa.org.uk) know of your team name and members
2. Compete at a BPA National competition in the same discipline at a higher level
3. Send your invoice/receipts the BPA (via the Committee Secretary – [skydive@bpa.org.uk](mailto:skydive@bpa.org.uk)) and provided the above criteria is met the funding will be allocated.

The offer of support will be subject to budget allocation, meeting the specific criterion and assessment against experience including previous years' averages. Verification of team line-up may be sought from the BPA Officials attending the event and/or the entry form.

The Competitions Committee may from time-to-time withdraw this funding offer – notably in instances where teams have incorporated a senior category team member as coach/team member. This will be done entirely at the Committee's discretion and a team has the right to appeal the decision
